



# Rapid Re-Housing for Homeless Veterans-OC (RRHHV-OC)



- Daily Living Services (referrals)
- Housing Counseling Services
- Transportation Services
- Temporary Financial Assistance (If eligible and if available.)
- Legal Services
- Fiduciary and Payee Services (Referrals)
- Personal Financial planning Services

### Who is Eligible?

- Single veteran or veteran household
- A Head of household or spouse of head of household must have served in U.S. Military
- A Veteran of U.S. military branch with:
  - a dishonorable discharge; or
  - other than honorable (Has exhausted SSVF Rapid Re-housing program services)
- Must not be VA healthcare eligible
- Must meet income eligibility criteria based on area median income for program area.
- Currently literally homeless or currently enrolled and receiving services from a Rapid Re-housing program in which status prior to enrollment was homeless and has maxed out on assistance.

### Required Documentation: (Not needed at screening. We can help you obtain.)

- DD-214 Form (we can assist in obtaining)
- Proof of income (Employment stubs, General Relief, bank statements, DPSS/EDD printout, SSI/SSDI)
- Homelessness verification by an agency of RRHHV-OC staff.
- Social Security and Identification cards for all adults. In household
- Copy of birth certificate and Social Security for all children in household.
- Other documentation as requested

*The goal of RRHHV-OC is to help veteran families who are homeless or at-risk of homelessness to quickly regain stability in permanent housing after experiencing a housing crisis.*
